This is a rand denominated offshore fund exposed to general market risk, exchange rate risk, liquidity risk and legal and regulatory risks, but likely to grow exponentially. The investable businesses and ideas are based on years of rigorous scientific research and supported by significant research and development by the Oxford University, and are tested and validated by professional researchers and academics, subject to peer review and overseen by global business leaders and investors acting as funders and advisors.

EVOX THERAPEUTICS is harnessing the natural delivery capabilities in the human body to treat serious diseases. Exosomes are nanosized vesicles secreted by all cells in the human body and is the natural way cells deliver proteins and nucleic acids to other cells. Evox has developed technology using the body's Exosomes to deliver drugs in nanoparticles to specifically targeted organs in isolation such as the Brain and central nervous system, reducing toxicity to other parts of the body.

VACCITECH developed two viral vector vaccines, one to prevent influenza and the other to treat prostate cancer. It is also in the race to produce a vaccine for **COVID-19**, which is already in human testing trials.

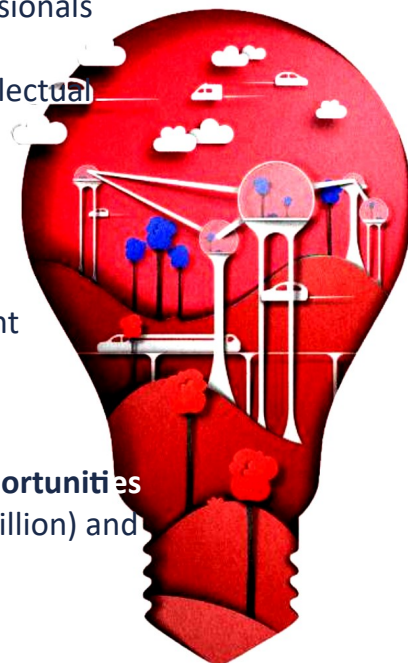

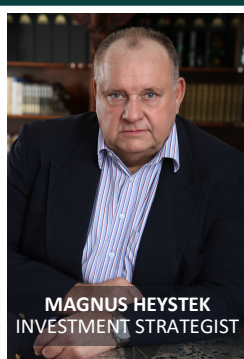
